Dr. Enrique Eguiarte, “*The Biblical Exegesis of Augustine on the Letter to the Galatians*”

Prof. Eguiarte is a professor at the Institutum Patristicum Augustinianum in Rome and the director of two scholarly journals: *AVGVSTINVS* and *Mayéutica*.
